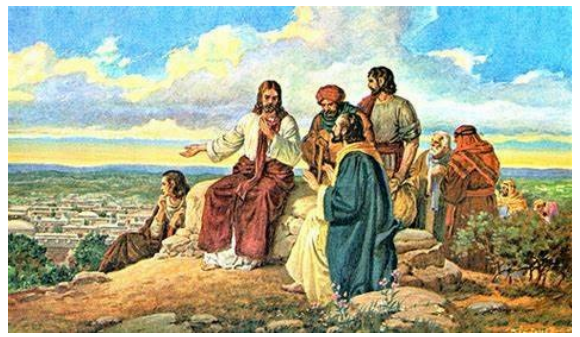

**Message from Father Steve,  
Pope Francis proclaims “Year of St. Joseph”**

Pope Francis recalls the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a “Year of Saint Joseph” from 8 December 2020 to 8 December 2021. This past Friday, we celebrated the feast day of St. Joseph the Worker. In our Catholic culture, St. Joseph takes a back seat to our Blessed Mother in the importance of raising Jesus. In a new Apostolic Letter entitled *Patris corde* (“With a Father’s Heart”), Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph a beloved father, an tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows. The Holy Father wrote *Patris corde* against the backdrop of the Covid-19 pandemic, which, he says, has helped us see more clearly the importance of “ordinary” people who, though far from the limelight, exercise patience and offer hope every day. In this, they resemble Saint Joseph, “the man who goes unnoticed, a daily, discreet and hidden presence,” who nonetheless played “an incomparable role in the history of Salvation.” “A carpenter who earned an honest living to provide for this family,”

St. Joseph also teaches us “the value, the dignity and the joy of what it means to eat bread that is the fruit of one’s own labor.” This aspect of Joseph’s character provides Pope Francis the opportunity to launch an appeal in favor of work, which has become “a burning social issue” even in countries with a certain level of well-being. “there is a renewed need to appreciate the importance of dignified work, of which Saint Joseph is an exemplary patron,” the Pope writes. At the conclusion of *Patris corde*, he writes a prayer for all of us to say.

We will be incorporating the Prayer of St. Joseph in the celebration of Mass, immediately following the Universal Prayers of the Faithful. Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer; Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To you, God entrusted his only Son; in you, Mary placed her trust with you, Christ became man. Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage, and defend us from every evil. Amen.

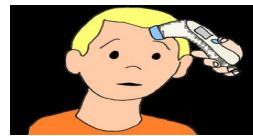


**Outsiders Seeking Jesus.**

- What of my life am I willing to lose for the benefit of eternal life?

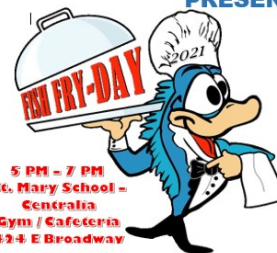

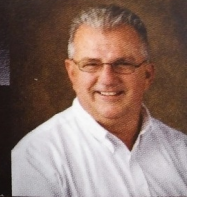

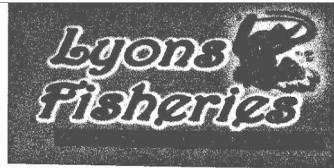
